



Would you like to pay your annual fee via electronic payment?




Do you support routine property inspections for homeowners compliance with the Hickory Farms Deed & Declarations and Rules & Regulations?




If so, how often should these inspections occur?




Do you feel it's important to have a neighborhood watch in our community




Are you willing to be a member of the neighborhood watch?




Have you personally experienced or seen any of the following?




Would you like to have speed bumps in the neighborhood?




Do you believe having a neighborhood watch keeps down the crime rate in our neighborhood?




Do you feel safer knowing we have a neighborhood watch




Within the past year, how often have you or your family used the Common Areas?




I use the areas for...




How often do you use the North paved asphalt walkway or the unpaved footpath along Rabbit Run




Please select all that may of interest to you and your family




Are you and your family members willing to volunteer to help in the Common Areas with the following? Select all that apply




Have you participated in any of the following events? Select all that apply




Would you be interested in more events that are?





Absolutely no speed bumps

A bench or two along the Upper Northern Path would be nice. Please cut hazardous branches from the trees that overhang the Northern Path (which is very busy), as well as those protruding over sidewalks into the streets of the community from folks' yards. People should trim their trees and bushes that have grown massively this summer. In some cases, the trees are meeting each other in the middle of the street.

Mail boxes need to be addressed (no pun intended). Many are falling forward and/or need painted or repaired. Not a good look for our caring community.

Pay attention to property appearance so that value will be maintained. There is a trash can that makes its daily home in front of the garage on our left, and one on a property to our right that sits in front of the place that was built for it next to the garage and isn't being used for that purpose (only to dry rugs). Since we are older owners, our community's property value and appearance are very important to us — more so than the social activities that are available now.

Please, absolutely NO SPEED BUMPS!!!!!

Better identification and outreach to non-participating members.


