All are encouraged to connect with Hickory Farms by joining the Hickory Farms Listserv! Hickory Farms utilizes Google Groups to manager our listserv. If you don't have a Gmail account, you can sign up for one at http://www.gmail.com.

Once you have an account, visit https://groups.google.com/my-groups to sign into Google Groups. From there, you can go straight to http://groups.google.com/g/hickory-farms-hoa/ and click the "Ask to Join." In the Reason for Joining, please include your address, phone number, and own/rent status to include in the neighborhood directory.

Once your membership is approved, you'll receive emails when they are sent to the listserv. You can adjust your membership settings - like changing single emails to a weekly digest - in your Google Groups Settings.

HOW TO REPORT STREETLIGHT OUTAGES

QUICK SUMMARY

- Report streetlights out in your neighborhood to keep pedestrians visible and safe.
- Use our interactive streetlight reporting map to make it easier to report.
- You can use your phone's GPS location to find pole numbers and report outages.

Streetlights, like light bulbs at home, don't last forever.

One way you can help is by **reporting streetlight outages in your neighborhood** and in other areas you frequent.

Reporting an outage is simple and helps keeps neighborhoods safe; it also helps keep pedestrians visible and safe.

Streetlights along public roadways in Fairfax County are typically maintained by Dominion Virginia Power or the Northern Virginia Electric Cooperative (NOVEC). The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) operates the streetlights along interstates and at major interchanges.

We've created a new <u>Streetlight Reporting Map</u> to make it easier to identify pole numbers and report streetlight outages from your desktop or mobile device. The Streetlight Reporting Map shows streetlight service areas and individual streetlight locations and pole numbers in Fairfax County. You can now use your phone's GPS location to find pole numbers and report outages in your neighborhood and in other areas you frequent.

3 STEPS TO REPORT A STREETLIGHT OUTAGE

- 1. Look for the pole ID number, which can be found on the pole.
- 2. If you can't find the pole number or if you notice a streetlight outage while driving, <u>use the online streetlight locator tool</u> to find pole numbers. Zoom in on the map to see streetlight locations.
- 3. After finding the streetlight on the map, report it online in the link provided on the map.
